QUALICUM BAY – HORNE LAKE WATERWORKS DISTRICT

BYLAW NO. 172

A bylaw for fixing tolls and other charges payable to the improvement district, the terms of payment thereof, and providing for a penalty to encourage prompt payment thereof.

The Trustees of Qualicum Bay - Horne Lake Waterworks District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

The following tolls are hereby fixed and make payable by all owners of land in the improvement district to which water is delivered from the works of the improvement district:

In this Bylaw:

Single Metered Toll shall mean the use of water for a single unit.

Multiple Unit Toll shall mean each unit of a multiple dwelling, each unit of a mobile home park, each self-contained suite in a single-family dwelling, and each store, office, hall, church or classroom.

1. Single Metered Toll:

2. Multiple Unit Toll:

Minimum quarterly toll for the first 62 m3 or any part thereof (per unit).	\$ 64.10
Each additional M3 from 62 to 72 m3.	\$ 1.10
Each additional M3 from 72 to 100 m3.	\$ 1.32
Each additional M3 exceeding 100 m3.	\$ 1.60

- 3. All meters shall be read quarterly. At the end of the three-month period, the minimum toll shall be billed. In addition, the quarterly volume in excess of such minimums as shown by the readings shall be charged at the rate as shown herein. Such billings shall be due and payable thirty (30) days from the billing date. A penalty charge based on 20% of the water toll billing will be applied as a one-time charge to any overdue accounts.
- 4. The Trustees may by resolution order the water shut off to any premises on which there are any tolls or other charge owing for sixty (60) days or longer.

- 5. In addition to the aforementioned charges, there is fixed and made payable to the District by every owner and occupier of premises in respect to which a request is made to the District to turn the water on, a charge of \$50.00 for each time this is done.
- 6. This Bylaw repeals Bylaw No. 168, the "Twenty Third Tolls Bylaw".
- 7. This Bylaw may be cited as the **"Twenty Forth Tolls Bylaw"** and will be effective **April 1, 2021**
